AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HORSES IN CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to quarter, ride or use horses or have in their possession horses on Dauphin Island in the following areas of the corporate limits: PROHIBITED AREAS: One mile west of Westward Ho Street to the Easternmost limits of the Town.

2. This ordinance shall not be applicable to horses used in parades, for law enforcement purposes or community events sponsored or approved by the Town of Dauphin Island or for horses licensed or approved by the Town of Dauphin Island for specific purposes.


3. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the Town jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or by both. the Court may impose community service or hard labor in lieu of fine or imprisonment or a period thereof.

This ordinance shall be effective as of 3 JULY, 1990.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1,
OF ORDINANCE NO. 27. PROHIBITING
HORSES IN CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE
TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island,
Alabama as follows:

Section 1, Ordinance No. 27, is hereby amended by striking the words "...in the following areas of the corporate limits..." and "...One mile West of"...

Section 1, Ordinance No. 27, revised, will read as follows: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to quarter, ride or use horses on Dauphin Island. Prohibited Areas: Westward Ho Street to the Easternmost limits of the Town.
