ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR DRIVEN TRAFFIC
ON BEACHES AND SAND DUNES, ON THE MISSISSIPPI
SOUND.

"BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN
ISLAND, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

"Section 1. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor driven
vehicle on the beaches and sand dunes along the Mississippi Sound
in an area zoned as a Conservation-Park District (C-P); provided
that vehicles engaged in construction, maintenance and repair
projects may be operated pursuant to permits issued by the Building
Inspector for the Town of Dauphin Island.


"Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance, upon
conviction, shall be guilty of violation of municipal ordinance and
shall be fined not less than \$100.00 but not more than \$500.00 plus
cost of court.

"Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on adoption
by the Town Council and approved this 21st day of May,
1991."
