ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THREATENING, VICIOUS, ATTACKING, SNARLING AND SNAPPING DOGS IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. No dog owner in the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama shall allow his dog or dogs to run loose within the corporate limits of the Town and endanger the health or safety of any person.

2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be issued a warning ticket by the Police Chief or any Police Officer.

3. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance, after being issued a warning ticket shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the Town Jail for a period not to exceed ten (10) days or by both such fine and imprisonment. The court in its discretion may impose community service or hard labor in lieu of fine or imprisonment.
