TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HORSES WITHIN THE
TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA AND EXCEPTIONS
THERE TO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of
Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or
corporation to quarter, ride or use horses or have in their
possession horses with the town limits of the Town of Dauphin
Island.

2. This ordinance excepts and shall not be applicable
to horses used in parades, for law enforcement purposes,
events sponsored and approved by the Town of Dauphin Island
or horses specifically licensed or approved by the Town of
Dauphin Island for specific purposes.

3. A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by
a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the
Town Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days or by
both such fine and imprisonment. The court in its discretion
may impose community service or hard labor in lieu of fine or
imprisonment.

4. Ordinance No. 27 relating to the prohibition of
horses is hereby repealed upon the effective date of this
ordinance.
