ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER RESTRICT THE USE OF FIREWORKS OR PYROTECHNICS WITHIN THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. Definitions. Meaning of "fireworks" whenever used in this ordinance shall mean all articles of fireworks as are now or hereafter classified as U.S. Department of Transportation Class C common fireworks in the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation for the transportation of explosive and other dangerous articles.

2. Definitions. Meaning of "Special Fireworks" whenever used in this ordinance shall mean all articles of fireworks that are classified as Class B explosives in the regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation, including all articles classified as fireworks other than those classified as Class C.

3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to ignite, explode or discharge any Class C pyrotechnics or fireworks with the town limits of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama except from the period of June 20 thru July 10th and December 15 thru January 2nd of each year; and at such other times as may be authorized by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

4. It shall be unlawful to possess or use Class B fireworks unless a proper permit is obtained from the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama and upon the recommendation of the Fire Chief for said town.

~~X~~. The foregoing restrictions are ~~a~~cumulative and in addition to the prohibitions and penalties provided in Code of Alabama, 1975, Title 8, Section 17-210 thru 225.

5. Penalty. Any person, firm, partnership or corporation that violates any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$500 or imprisonment for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days or both at the discretion of the Court.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its

adoption and publication.
