AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 44A KNOWN AS THE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE TOWN OWNED DOCK AT BILLY GOAT HOLE. EAST END OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. To amend the title of Ordinance No. 44, to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE TOWN OWNED DOCK AT BILLY GOAT HOLE, ALSO KNOWN AS, MURPHY'S BAY AND/OR GOVERNMENT CUT. EAST END OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA

2. To delete Section One, DEFINITIONS, Paragraph (a), of Ordinance No. 44 and substitute therefor the following:

1. DEFINITIONS.

(a) Town Dock means the newly constructed dock on the eastern portion of town property adjacent to the boat launching ramps at Billy Goat Hole, also known as, Murphy's Bay and/or Government Cut, on the eastern part of Dauphin Island.

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE TOWN OWNED DOCK AT BILLY GOAT HOLE, EAST END OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS. (a) Town Dock means the newly constructed dock on the eastern portion of town property adjacent to the boat launching ramps at Billy Goat Hole on the eastern part of Dauphin Island.

(b) Commercial Boats or Vessels means all boats, ships or waterborne vessels that are used in construction, commercial shrimping, fishing, crabbing, crew transport vessels and any waterborne craft used in the construction or service of any off shore oil well platforms or pipelines.

(c) Recreational boats are vessels used for sport, sport fishing including charter boats; private recreational boats used for recreational fishing or water sports including underwater diving.

2. The Municipal Dock is hereby set aside for the exclusive use by recreational boats or sports craft unless a special permit or authorization is issued ~~by the Mayor or the governing body~~ of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

3. No boat, vessel or other waterborne craft may secure itself to this dock for more than a reasonable time for loading and unloading unless permission has been given by the ~~Mayor or governing body~~ for extended dock time.

4. The dock shall always remain available for emergency use by any vessel.

5. Violations by any person, firm, partnership or corporations of the provisions of this ordinance may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$200 or a term in the Town jail not to exceed thirty (30) days or both.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication.
