ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING
PARKING IN SPECIFIED PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:


Section 1. The Town of Dauphin Island with respect to streets, courts, avenues, and rights-of-way within the corporate limits of the Town and under its jurisdiction, may place signs prohibiting or restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any street, court, avenue and rights-of-way, where in its opinion, as evidence by regulation, such stopping, standing or parking of vehicles is dangerous to those using the streets, courts, avenues and rights-of-way where the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic thereon. Such signs shall be official signs and no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on such signs.

Section 2. The Town of Dauphin Island and/or Chief of Police may prohibit or restrict parking in designated areas by placing signs indicating the prohibition or restriction.

Section 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined an amount not to exceed \$500.00 or sentenced to hard labor for the Town, not to exceed 6 months, one or both.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its posting and approval as required by law.


