

ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF MOBILE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT RULES FOR THE TOWN'S MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That an Ordinance entitled Health and Human Services is hereby adopted to provide for the enforcement of Mobile County Health Department Rules as defined by the Alabama Department of Public Health pursuant to Title 22 of the Health and Environmental Control, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, for prosecution of violation of these rules within the police jurisdiction of the Town in the Town of Dauphin Island Court as follows:

SECTION 1

ENFORCEMENT OF MOBILE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT RULES

- (a) The Mobile County Health Department Rules as defined by the Alabama Department of Public Health pursuant to Title 22 of the Health and Environmental Control, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, are the health regulations of the Town of Dauphin Island.
- (b) The Mobile County Health Officer is the Health Officer of the town of Dauphin Island pursuant to Title 22 of the Health and Environmental Control, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.
- (c) Any person found guilty of violating any provision of the Rules of the Mobile County health Department as adopted pursuant to State law within the Town limits, or the police jurisdiction of the town, shall be prosecuted in accordance with the jurisdiction of the Town of Dauphin Island Municipal Court and shall be punished by a fine of not more than FIVE HUNDRED & 00/100 (\$500.00) DOLLARS, or by imprisonment in jail for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by community service, or by both such fine and imprisonment and/or community service at the discretion of the Judge, unless otherwise prohibited by State law.

SECTION II

REPEALER

All Town of Dauphin Island ordinances, or parts thereof, and any ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III
SEVERABILITY

If any section, sentence, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance and it shall be construed to have been the intent of the Town Council of the town of Dauphin Island to pass this Ordinance without such unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative part therein, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed and held to be valid as if such part had not been included therein.

SECTION IV
EFFECT OF ORDINANCE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect within the Town of Dauphin Island and its police jurisdiction.


