

ORDINANCE NO. 64-C

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 64-B
RELATING TO THE SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR FIRST TIME VIOLATIONS AND
AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN TOWN
EMPLOYEES TO ISSUE MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND,
ALABAMA, as follows:

Ordinance No. 64-B Article 2 is amended as follows:

The schedule of Ordinances subject to enforcement by Municipal Offense Ticket and associated fines is replaced in its entirety by the following table:

MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET

Violations of the following Municipal Ordinances, as may be amended from time to time, shall be punishable by the issuance of a Municipal Offense Ticket:

Ordinance No. 64-B Article 3.1 is amended as follows:

- 3.1 When any law enforcement officer, building inspector, zoning enforcement officer, investigator, auditor, public works director, public safety officer, or other employee of the Town of Dauphin Island, designated by a Town Ordinance or by appointment by the Mayor as a law enforcement officer, finds any violation or violations of any Municipal Ordinance as set forth in Section 2 entitled Municipal Offense Ticket hereinabove, which he is authorized and required to enforce, said law enforcement office may issue, on forms provided by the Town, a Town of Dauphin Island Municipal Offense Ticket and deliver same to the person in violation of such Municipal Ordinance. The Municipal Offense Ticket shall direct said person to appear in Municipal Court of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama at a time and on a date stated therein to answer to the charge or charges for violation of such Municipal Ordinance that shall be stated in said Municipal Offense Ticket. However, in the alternative, if the violation is the first violation of such Municipal Ordinance by the person cited, such person, in lieu of appearing in Municipal Court pursuant to the Municipal Offense Ticket, may pay the appropriate fine and Court costs pursuant to the terms stated in Section 2 entitled Municipal Offense Ticket hereinabove, and on the Municipal Offense Ticket, in addition to either of the following:

Ordinance No. 64-B Article 3.3 is amended as follows:

- 3.3 The officers, building inspectors, zoning enforcement officers, investigators, auditors, public safety officers, or other employees designated by Municipal law or appointment by the mayor as a law enforcement officer and authorized to issue Municipal Offense Tickets as herein provided are hereby further authorized to swear out warrants and execute Affidavits or Complaints charging such person or persons with any violation of Municipal law without first having issued a Municipal Offense Ticket for such violation.

Ordinance No. 64-B Article 3.4 is amended as follows:

- 3.4 Any law enforcement officer, Police Officer, building inspector, zoning officer/official, public safety officer or Town Clerk employed by the Town of Dauphin Island is designated by the Ordinance as a law enforcement officer and is authorized to issue a Municipal Offense Ticket for violations of any Municipal Ordinance set forth in Section 2 of Ordinance 64-B.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. This Ordinance applies to property within the Town limits and police jurisdiction of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama and shall be in force and effect therein.


