

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

DISASTER DEBRIS REMOVAL, DISPOSAL AND REDUCTION SERVICES

The Town of Dauphin Island Alabama, is soliciting proposals from qualified contractors for Disaster Debris Removal, Disposal and Reduction Services. Sealed proposals will be received at Town Hall, 1011 Bienville Blvd., Dauphin Island, AL, 36528 until 1:00 p.m. (CST) on Friday, November 20, 2020, and then publicly opened for furnishing all labor and materials, and performing all work required by the Town of Dauphin Island and described as disaster debris removal, disposal and reduction services for hurricane debris within the Town of Dauphin Island. All proposals must be submitted in accordance with the RFP document. Proposers must be authorized to do business in the State of Alabama. Proposal documents will be on file and may be seen in the Town Clerk's Office of the Town of Dauphin Island at Town Hall, 1011 Bienville Blvd., Dauphin Island, AL 36528 or requested by email at wsandagger@townofdauphinisland.org.

A mandatory pre-proposal conference will be held in the Council Chambers at Town Hall at 1 PM (CST) on November 10, 2020. Prospective contractors will be deemed disqualified if not in attendance. No proposal document will be issued to prospective contractors later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the time indicated above for receiving proposals.

No proposal will be considered unless the proposer, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified to submit a proposal for this type of work in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Alabama. In addition, non-residents of the State, if a corporation, shall show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in the State of Alabama.

Prospective contractors must make their own estimates of the facilities and difficulties related to the performance of the proposal, including local conditions, uncertainty of weather, and all other contingencies.

The Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, will not furnish any labor, materials, or supplies unless specifically provided in the proposal document.

Proposals shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes or packages, addressed to Town Clerk, Wanda Sandagger, labeled on the outside "Town of Dauphin Island Disaster Debris Removal, Disposal and Reduction Services" and "Name of Proposing Company" to be opened at 1:15 pm (CST) at Town Hall on Friday, November 20, 2020.
