## Town Announces Council Place 3 Vacancy

The Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island officially announced the Council Place 3 vacancy at its regular meeting on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 and developed a process for interested citizens to submit their names for consideration. Candidates must meet certain eligibility requirements such as (but not limited to); (a) be a minimum of 18 years of age, (b) be a registered voter and (c) be a resident of Dauphin Island for at least ninety (90) days prior to appointment to Council. To assist the Council with its decision, candidates are asked to submit a current resume/bio, and answer the following two questions; (1) Why do you want to be a Council Member? (2) What is/are your primary goal(s) as a Council Member? This information must be submitted to Town Hall **NO LATER THAN** noon (CST) on Tuesday, October 20, 2015 to be included for consideration by the Town Council. The appointed individual will serve the remaining term of Council Member Philip Patronas (who passed away on September 19, 2015) which will expire on the first Monday in November 2016. Town Council Members receive \$400 monthly, are expected to attend two Agenda and two Council Meetings per month (along with other duties and responsibilities) and are subject to random drug testing along with all Town employees.
