

TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX AND PRESCRIBE A SPEED LIMIT FOR MOTOR VEHICLES OPERATING ON THE THOROUGHFARES, STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, in the State of Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. The maximum speed authorized for motor vehicles within the corporate limits of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, is hereby set at 30 mph on all thoroughfares, streets and other public rights-of-way unless otherwise provided herein.

Section 2. The lawful maximum speed allowable on LeMoyne Drive from the Town Limits to Bienville Boulevard is 45 mph; and on Bienville Boulevard from east end to west end is 40 mph unless otherwise marked.

Section 3. The lawful speed limit within a school zone as designated by State Law within the corporate limits of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama is hereby fixed at 15 mph during school hours.

Section 4. The Mayor and Chief of Police may reduce maximum speed limits by the erection of signs indicating the reduced limits, where hazardous or emergency conditions are indicated. Reduced speeds provided for by said signs shall be the legal maximum speed in the areas so indicated.

Section 5. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined an amount not to exceed \$ 500⁰⁰ or sentenced to hard labor for the Town, not to exceed 6 MONTHS; ONE OR BOTH.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its posting and approval as required by law.
