

TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND

ORDINANCE NO. 13A
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 13 TO ESTABLISH
TO THE POSITION OF TOWN ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN
ISLAND, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, that Ordinance No.13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established the position of Town Attorney for the Town Of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

Section 2. The Town Attorney must be licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama, be a qualified elector of Mobile County, Alabama, and shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Town Council.

Section 3. Duties of the town attorney shall be

(a) The Town Attorney will attend all meetings of the Town Council unless Specifically excused by the Mayor.

(b) The Town Attorney shall prepare all ordinances, resolution and motions upon request.

(c) The Town Attorney shall render legal advice upon request of the Council to the various Town Department Heads.

(d) The Town Attorney shall prosecute all cases in the Municipal Court.

(e) The Town Attorney shall be responsible for the legal matters of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

Section 4. The compensation of the Town Attorney shall be as follows:

(a) The Town Attorney shall be paid the sum of \$1,000.00 retainer per month. The Council may revise this amount from time to time.

(b) The Town Attorney shall handle all legal matters of the Town, including appeals from the Municipal Court to the Circuit Court of Mobile County, Alabama.

(c). The Town Attorney shall be paid such compensation as agreed upon in each instance involved in the assistance and preparation of municipal bond issues and assessment projects in cooperation with specially engaged bond counsel, and for capital and special improvement projects involving unusual or complex legal questions.

(b) The Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama shall reimburse the Town Attorney

for all expenses billed by him including but not limited to photocopies, court costs, long distance telephone charges, travel costs and any other actual expense items.

(e) The time period covered by this-agreement shall be January 1, 1992 - December 31, 1992.

TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF TOWN ATTORNEY FOR THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin. Island, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established the position of Town Attorney for the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

Section 2. The Town Attorney must be licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama, be a qualified elector of Motile County, Alabama, and shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Town Council.

Section 3. Duties of the Town Attorney shall be:

(a) The Town Attorney will attend all meetings of the own Council unless specifically excused by the Mayor;

(b) The Town Attorney shall prepare all ordinances, resolutions and motions upon request.

(c) The town Attorney shall render legal advice upon request of the Council to the various Town Department Heads.

(d) The Town Attorney shall temporarily prosecute all cases in the Municipal Court.

(e) The Town Attorney shall be responsible for the legal matters of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama.

Section 4. The compensation of the Town Attorney shall be as follows:

(a) The Town Attorney shall initially be paid the sum of \$1,500.00 retainer per month. The Council may revise this amount from time to time.

(b) The Town Attorney shall be compensated at his regular hourly rate for handling all legal matters of the Town of Dauphin island including appeals from the Municipal Court except those matters described above

in Paragraphs 3 (a), (b), (c) and (d);

(c) The Town Attorney shall be paid such compensation as agreed upon in each instance involved in the assistance and preparation of municipal bond issues and assessment projects in cooperation with specially engaged bond counsel, and for capital and special improvements projects involving unusual or complex legal questions

(d) The Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama shall reimburse the Town Attorney for all expenses billed by him, including but not limited to photocopies, court costs, long Distance telephone charges, travel costs and any, other actual expenses items.
