ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE USE OF TOWN
PROPERTIES AND TOWN RIGHTS OF WAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of
Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. No person, firm or corporation shall build, install
or establish any structure or place any culvert, driveway,
bridge or overpass on any easement, right of way or property
owned or controlled by the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama,
without the express written permission of the Town Council.

2. Any person found guilty of violating any provision
of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more
than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the town jail or at hard
labor for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both
such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the judge
trying the case. Each day such violation is permitted to
continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be
punished as such thereunder. Any person found guilty of any
of the provisions of this ordinance may, at the discretion of
the Court be punished by fine, imprisonment, or in the
alternative, may be sentenced to community service as
designated by the court in lieu of fine or imprisonment.

3. The Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama may, after the
adoption of this ordinance, remove, alter or modify any
structure, culvert, driveway, bridge or overpass at the
expense of the owner of the property adjacent thereto.

This ordinance shall be effective as of Jan 23,
1990.
