ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE BANNING GLASS  
THE GULF OF MEXICO

Repealed

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dauphin Island, Alabama, as follows:

1. Definition: Gulf of Mexico Beaches of Dauphin Island is defined as those beaches on the southside of Dauphin Island, extending around the easternmost tip of Dauphin Island to the public pier; those beaches to the south of most westerly portion of said Dauphin Island.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or use on the Gulf of Mexico beach located in the corporate limits with police jurisdiction of the Town of Dauphin Island any container made of glass or other material that is subject to breaking, shattering or disintegrate, leaving sharp edges which are likely to cause injury to any person on said Gulf beach.

3. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the Town jail for a period not to exceed 90 days or by both. The court may impose community service or hard labor in lieu of fine or imprisonment or a portion thereof.

This ordinance shall be effective as of 3 JULY, 1990.
